As with anything else, there are certain rules for vaping that an individual must adhere to in order to respect everyone else's personal space and beliefs. Compiled here are just a few things that vapers can do in order to appropriately be considerate and respectful of others in public.

- ***A vaper must always be aware of their surroundings.*** In a public setting, such as a restaurant or store, one should ask if it is okay to vape there. If vaping is permitted, one must still make sure to keep their vapor low and reasonable. If one is told not to vape, respect their wishes.
